M4 Junctions 3 – 12 Upgrade to smart motorway – upcoming weekend closures

We are writing to tell you about two upcoming weekend closures of the M4 motorway for bridge and carriageway work, which form part of the M4 junctions 3 to 12 smart motorway upgrade project.

- **The M4 will be closed in both directions over the weekend of 21-23 February 2020 between Junctions 4b (M25) and 5 (Langley).** This is for the demolition of Old Slade Lane bridge near junction 4b, which will be replaced by the end of 2020. The closure will start after 8pm Friday 21 February and the motorway will reopen by 6am on Sunday 23 February, in order to clear the way for traffic travelling to and from the Six Nations match at Twickenham.
- **The M4 will also be closed in both directions over the weekend of 7-9 March 2020 between junctions 3 (Hayes) and 4 (Heathrow Airport).** This is for essential work on the carriageway and motorway infrastructure. Again, there is a Six Nations match at Twickenham that weekend so the closure will start at 10pm Saturday 7 March and the motorway will reopen by 6am on Monday 9 March.

The diversion routes for motorway traffic during these weekends have been agreed with the local authorities as part of the Development Consent Order process. Traffic will be diverted via the local highways network and nearby motorways depending on the direction of travel. Strategic diversions will also be in place on the wider motorway network to direct traffic away from this part of the M4, utilising the M25, M3 and M40. We would advise you to use alternative routes or public transport if possible, during these two weekends.
